Casa Perea is a multipurpose facility, a 5,400 sq ft. traditional adobe and terrone

structure that dates to circa 1850, and is listed on the New Mexico historical registry as a prime example of Territorial style architecture. Over the Casa's nearly 170 years, it has served as a family residence, a dance hall, the Sandoval County Courthouse, a church, a restaurant, a wine-making cellar, a reception hall for the San Yisidro Church, and an

event center for weddings, art exhibits, and concerts.

Pachamama Two rooms are dedicated to Pachamama, the owner's retail store specializing since 1974 in Latin American folk art and Spanish Colonial antiques. We offer traditional jewelry, antique and contemporary folk art, market toys, textiles, books, notecards, and miniatures. Our hundreds of hand-finished silver milagros are a specialty. We are open Wednesday through Saturday 10am to 5 pm or by appointment.

The additional seven rooms throughout the building are furnished with authentic antiques from Peru, Mexico, Bolivia, Guatemala, and New Mexico. Two rooms with a separate entrance, bathroom, fireplace, patio, and parking are available as short-term rentals.

Casa Perea is a handsome, traditional multi-purpose facility intended to serve the Corrales community and visitors. The interior and exterior space can be rented for arts-related activities, concerts, receptions, classes, seminars, meetings, and celebrations of all kinds, including weddings. The 62×15 ft. wooden dance floor connects outside to a 100 ft long pergola hung with wisteria, trumpet vine and climbing roses. The garden's lawns are surrounded by roses, lilacs, fruit trees, aromatic herbs, and flowers, with a small vineyard at the entrance to the property. The building and grounds are handicapped accessible.


Harvest Festival, firmly establish Corrales as a Sunday market destination.


with Corrales artists to include their artwork within the anthology *Passages*.
